

# India 2010 – Short-term Missions Trip



**Who:** The Banjara village people of India. They are one of the largest unreached people groups in the world.

**What:** A unique experience to share the gospel one-to-one, one-to-many, hut-to-hut, and village-to-village. Last year God used us to share with over 3,600 people; 357 professed faith in Christ, and over 420 desired to know more! Plus, 30 house churches were born!

**Why:** Of the 12,000 plus remote villages there are 8,000 that have never had anyone visit them with the gospel. Last year we were able to reach 79 villages.

**Where:** Andhra Pradesh, India (Central, Southern part of India)

**When:** July 21- August 1, 2010 (only 1 ½ weeks)

**How:** We teamed up with native Christians and Pastors. We share, they translate. We experienced first hand how God's Spirit can use ordinary people like us to directly reach people that have never heard of the name of Christ before!
