Greetings campers! We would like to take this opportunity to share the following information with you to prepare you for an exciting weekend of learning and spiritual growth at camp.

1. **DATES:** Friday, August 22, 3:00 p.m. – Sunday, August 24, 6:15 p.m.

2. **BUS RIDERS:** There will be one (1) bus going up to camp this year. Luggage check-in is Friday, August 22, 11:00 a.m. in the MPB (gym).

For bus boarding, please meet in the MPB **no later than 11:30 a.m.** on Friday, August 22. You can park your vehicle under the new Sanctuary (do not park on the street). **If you are unable to make it down to church by 11:30 a.m., please call the church office (213) 687-0814 and let Nathaniel Li or the church secretary know.** The bus will be **returning** to church after dinner on Sunday, August 24. Please make arrangements to be picked up.

Luggage is restricted to no more than (2) pieces per person. When you pack, please follow these suggestions:

- A. Carry all medicines, valuables, and cameras personally.
 - B. Tie all loose items (sheets, blankets, etc.) in a bundle.
 - C. Label all luggage with your name and address.
3. **DRESS CODE:** Casual for morning & evening message sessions. **Sunday attire is recommended for the Sunday worship session.** Those serving in the Children's program may dress nice casual for Sunday worship. Be sure to bring some warm clothing for the evenings. The weather in the evening at Big Bear is usually cold. Bring an umbrella just in case it rains. See the Camp Packing List for other suggestions.
 4. **CABIN ASSIGNMENTS:** More than one family may be assigned to a cabin. Individual campers may be paired with others in their age group and gender.

Deluxe vs Standard Housing: If you requested deluxe housing, towels and linens will be provided in your room. If you have requested standard housing, you will need to bring your own towels, pillows, and sheets (or sleeping bag).

Childcare Workers: Childcare workers (completed 7th grade and above) are housed together in the standard dorms and will need to bring their own towels, pillows, and sheets (or sleeping bag).

5. **CHECK-IN UPON ARRIVAL** (in front of Ponderosa Lodge):
Friday dinner is scheduled for 5:00 p.m. If you are planning to have dinner at camp on Friday, please arrive by 4:30 p.m. to check in. You will be directed to the location of your cabin. If you arrive between 5:00 p.m. and 6:00 p.m., please park in the main lot and go directly to the Dining Room for dinner.

Cabin keys and welcome materials should be picked up at the check-in table.

6. **BABY CRIBS:** It is recommended by our camp staff that parents bring a portable crib for their baby under one year old.
7. **HEALTH CONSIDERATIONS:**
 - A. Medications should be turned in to the camp nurse upon check-in at camp. Adults choosing to keep their medications or their child's medication must store them in a locked suitcase or receptacle.
 - B. Rest and naps are recommended during free time. Remember, the air is thinner and contains less oxygen in the mountains.
 - C. Drink carbonated beverages in moderation. Limit your intake of milk and dairy products. This will prevent gas attacks. Drink plenty of fluids. Maintain regular bowel habits.

D. Wear insect repellent, especially in the evening hours. Avoid wearing strongly scented perfumed lotions. Long pants and sleeves should be worn in the evening.
